Scheduling and Enrollment

Students will be enrolled in courses unless otherwise notified. Summer school reserves the right to cancel classes, add new classes, combine classes or make any other changes to ensure the course integrity and success of the program.

Attendance Policy

Regular and punctual attendance is a requirement to participate in this program. The intense instruction is developed to focus on specific skills in order to improve student success over a relatively short period of time. In the event of an absence all time and missed assignments must be made up at the parent's or guardian's expense. The cost of tutoring is \$30 per hour. If students miss a class they will be expected to make up the two hours at the cost of \$60. If time is not made up before school is over, then the student will not receive credit for the course.

Parents/guardians are expected to call on the day of the student's absence. 401-683-2124

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Lateness Policy

A record of tardiness will be kept by the classroom teacher. Any student who is between 5-15 minutes tardy will be marked late. If a student is more than 15 minutes later for class or late more than 3 times over the course of the summer school session, his or her lateness will be considered an absence and her or she will be required to make up a full class period, at the parent's or guardian's expense.

Tuition and Refunds:

Tuition for Portsmouth and Little Compton 9-12 students is \$175.00 per course. Grade 8 courses are \$150 a piece. Out of district tuition is \$200 for grade 9-12 courses and \$175 for Grade 8 Courses. Application for tuition reduction is available to district residents. Refunds including late registration fees (\$30) will be given if a course is cancelled or if a student needs to withdraw before the start of a course. A written request for a refund must be sent to:

Transportation: All students are responsible for their own transportation. All students must be picked up no later than 10 minutes after their last class.

Behavior Policy:

Portsmouth Summer School students are held accountable for Portsmouth High School's Social and Civic Expectations.

Students who are asked to leave class due to rude, disruptive, non productive or inappropriate behavior will be warned ONE TIME. **A second dismissal from class will result in the student being dismissed from the program.** Students will then be required to make up the class during the next school year.

Break Time:

A five minute break time may be given during class at the teacher's discretion. Students on break are required to stay in the designated break area. Failure to do so will result in dismissal from summer school.

Students using alcohol, tobacco and other drugs or destroying school property will be **dismissed** from the program immediately. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

Academic Integrity:

Students caught cheating or plagiarizing will automatically **fail** summer school and the student will be forced to repeat the course in the fall.
